Under 18 fee is only \$75.00. This course is a VET approved course so can count towards a student's final school results. The course commences in on 18th July and has assessment on the 10th September just before our volunteer patrol season starts. Other benefits include access and use of our clubhouse and club equipment including our gym and entry to surf carnivals in events such as beach, water, and surf craft.
