Sunshine Beach State High School Music Excellence Program



Application

The Music Excellence Program at Sunshine Beach SHS demonstrates "Music Theory into BEST practice".

An integrated approach incorporating both Classroom and Instrumental music, the Music Excellence Program focuses on <u>academic excellence</u> through extension studies in music theory, combined with <u>performance excellence</u> through participation in our range of instrumental ensembles.

For musical students in Years 7 and 8, Sunshine Beach SHS offers the opportunity to be part of a Music Extension class, designed to encourage the pursuit of excellence in music. Students in this class study Music Extension as a core subject throughout years 7 and 8 (students in mainstream study music for only one term in year 8) and then as an elective subject in Year 9 and 10. They also undertake more advanced performing and classroom music activities, including completing AMEB Theory. Students are eligible for membership in school ensembles, depending on instrument (Concert Band, Stage Band, String Ensemble, Percussion Ensemble and/or Choir) and standard of ability.

Who should apply:

- Students who are involved in primary school <u>instrumental</u> programs (and play a woodwind, brass, percussion or orchestral stringed instrument), and/or
- Students who have <u>private music lessons</u> (e.g piano, guitar), and/or
- Students who are involved in <u>musical theatre or choral programs</u>

Applications:

- To apply to be part of this program, prospective parents / students complete the attached application form to register for an audition / interview time. Forms are to be sent to Attn: HOD Performing Arts, Sunshine Beach SHS, 45 Ben Lexcen Dr, Sunshine Beach Qld 4567. For consideration in the first round, these forms must be received no later than April 19.
- Students participate in a short audition/interview with the Head of Music. Auditions are held in the Music Block at SBSHS. NOTE: the performance component of the audition will be videorecorded to assist with decision-making. Offers for positions in the class are made throughout the year and may depend on factors including performance ability, academic rigour, and the needs of the music program to create balanced ensembles.

Pianists are often invited to join one of the percussion ensembles, or may also choose to learn another instrument or join the vocal program.
