Out of Catchment Application

The Music Excellence Program at Sunshine Beach SHS demonstrates "Music Theory into BEST practice".

An integrated approach incorporating both Classroom and Instrumental music, the Music Excellence Program focuses on <u>academic excellence</u> through extension studies in music theory, combined with <u>performance excellence</u> through participation in our range of instrumental ensembles.

Sunshine Beach SHS has an enrolment management plan (EMP). Students who reside outside the school's catchment area may still be eligible to enrol at Sunshine Beach SHS upon acceptance into the Music Excellence Program.

Successful application for Out of Catchment enrolment in the Music Excellence Program is not automatic, and is at the discretion of the Head of Department and the Principal. The following are mandatory conditions that must be met before an Out of Catchment Music Excellence application can be ratified.

- The student must be an existing, enrolled member of the Instrumental Music program at their current school.
- The student must complete the application form attached, and complete an audition on an accepted instrument (woodwind, brass, percussion or orchestral strings) with the Head of Department Performing Arts. NOTE: the performance component of the audition will be videorecorded to assist with decision-making.

<u>Auditions: Main round - May 1 to 10.</u> Forms are due no later than April 19. Further information can be found at: https://sunshinebeachhigh.eq.edu.au/curriculum/music/years-7-10-music-excellence-class

The student and at least one parent must have an interview with the Head of Performing Arts or the Director of Music to determine the benefit to the Sunshine Beach Music Excellence Program in accepting the student's Out of Catchment enrolment. This will include sighting a current school report.

 Although it is expected that students will continue their participation in Music for the duration of their enrolment, the student and parent must commit to the student's participation in both Classroom and Instrumental Music at Sunshine Beach SHS for a minimum of one year.
